SAP Introductory Workshop

The SAP Introductory Workshops are for faculty that are beginning to use the software for the first time and want to understand the fundamentals of using SAP, or that would like a refresher before commencing teaching. The course lasts 5 days and upon completion gives faculty a very rounded set of SAP skills as well as teaching materials and cases that can be immediately deployed. The course is open to any UA member from around the world.

The course will cover the new Global Bike Incorporated case study materials. These are the materials that form the core of the University Alliances teaching resources and are integrated across product lines (e.g. ERP, Business Intelligence, Supply Chain Management). So as well as gaining an understanding of ERP the course is an excellent introduction to the GBI concept and company case study.

The course materials include access to a live system, full copies of SAP training manuals and slides and access to two consultants from our 900-person strong Service and Support Centre in Ireland. This Centre provides technical support across Europe and the US and consultants typically have many, many years of SAP consulting so both their training expertise and anecdotal experience are second to none.
